# **2023 Summer Drill Tour**

## STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE

#### **GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION**

- 2023 Summer Drill Tour. This will be a group of rifle exhibition drill competitions conducted in-person and over the internet. The competitions included are as follows: River City Drill Competition (RCDC, live), DrillHub ODC (virtual), Alamo City Drill Competition (ACDC, virtual), and Drill Warrior University ODC-43 (virtual). Correspondence for each competition should be sent to their respective directors.
- **2. Style:** RCDC, DH ODC, and ACDC will be conducted as "street" competitions. DWU ODC-43 will be conducted as "semi-formal".
- **3. Organization**. Each competition will be responsible for their own entrants, SOP, and day-of operations.
- **4.** The Competitor. Competitors may be of any age or skill level, however bayonets MAY NOT be utilized unless the competitor is 18 years of age and graduated from high school.
- **5.** Entry Costs. RCDC will maintain separate entry costs due to being a live event. A combo entry of \$25 will enter competitors into DH ODC, ACDC, and DWU ODC-43. Competitors may also enter each competition individually with costs set by the individual organizers.
- 6. Entry Methods. Entry methods will be determined by individual competition directors. To enter with the combo package, payment should be made to Jonathan Ludwig through PayPal Friends & Family option with the email: jgl244888@yahoo.com and the name of the event director; Jonathan Ludwig. Other options: Venmo: @JonnyLudwig. CashApp: \$jgludw01. This is NON-REFUNDABLE except in special circumstances. The 4 directors will make this call.

- 7. Entry Deadlines. Entry deadlines will be determined by individual competition directors.
- 8. Registration: Fill out the Google Form found on ADR's website.

### SCHEDULE

1. Overall Plan. Video deadline will be on the "day of the comp", which will be defined below. A Password must be utilized in each video. This password will be released one week before the video deadline.

## SCORING AND REWARDS

- 1. Scoring. Each competitor's score from each competition will be added to compute "championship points". Championship points will be determined through the following method. The percentage of points given out of the total will be found and multiplied by 1000. Points will be rounded up if decimal 5 or higher, round down if 4 or lower.
  - a. Example: Winner scores 780/800. This person will receive 780/800 x 1000 = 975 points. Second place scores 750/800. This person will receive 750/800 x 1000 = 938 points.

#### 2. Live vs. Virtual Competitors

**a.** Due to the combined nature of this year's tour, live and virtual competitors will be scored together for SDT Champion purposes. Individual awards for Virtual and Live winners will be given out. To

balance out the advantages of competing virtually, namely multiple run-through attempts, all competitors of Live events will be given a +25 bonus to their SDT score.

#### 3. Tiebreakers.

- a. Level 1: Number of competitions entered
- **b.** Level 2: Number of competitions won
- c. Level 3: Number of Top 2 placements
- d. Level 4: Number of Top 3 placements
- **4. Rewards.** The champion will be whoever has the most championship points after all 4 competitions. The winner will receive a substantial cash prize provided by the organizations and entry fees.
  - **a.** Individual competition rewards will be determined by their respective organizers.
